2. ELIGIBILITY:

**CONTESTANTS NEED NOT QUALIFY BUT MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED.
THERE WILL BE NO REGISTRATION ON SITE.**

PRE-REGISTRATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY March 5, 2010. (NO-EXCEPTIONS)

3. ADMISSION FEES:

Day Pass	\$ 7.00 per person
All Tournament Pass:	\$ 10.00 per person
No Charge for Children under the age of 8	

4. COACHING:

Only TWO coaches per wrestler at mat side.

FLOOR PASSES:

# OF WRESTLERS	NUMBER OF FLOOR PASSES
0 – 24	One pass for every certified WAWA Coach but no more than five (5) total.
25 – Above	One pass for every certified WAWA Coach – five (5) total and one (1) additional pass for every five (5) wrestlers thereafter
ADDITIONAL FLOOR PASSES MAYBE PURCHASED FOR \$20.00 EACH BUT ONLY TO WAWA CERTIFIED COACHES	

CERTIFIED WAWA COACH:

- a. Current USA Wrestling Coach Card
- b. Copper or Above Coaching Certification
- c. Folkstyle Rules Clinic Card

5. RULES:

The rules of F.I.L.A. with current USA Wrestling modifications where applicable with current NFHS certification, will govern the event and the competition.

6. UNIFORMS:

One red and one blue singlet or a red/blue reversible singlet is required. A handkerchief is also required. All wrestlers are required to wear head gear.

7. INJURIES:

In the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Chief Medical Officer, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.

8. PAIRING:

WAWA will follow National and Regional Guidelines for pairing.
State Folkstyle will be line bracketing.

9. TEAM AWARDS:

WAWA State Plaques for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded. Female State Folkstyle will be awarded 1st Plaque. Team scoring structure: Each Club will designate 12 or less point getters from their club. **THIS LIST OF 12-POINT GETTERS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE STATE PAIRING DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE WITHIN AN HALF HOUR AFTER WEIGH-INS CLOSE NO EXCEPTIONS!!!** The total number of wrestlers must be on form along with the list of Mat and Pairing Officials. Pairing and Mat Officials must attend State Clinic to qualify for team points.

10. INDIVIDUAL AWARDS:

A. FOLKSTYLE - Medals will be given to the top six (6) place winners in each weight class.

11. IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

FEMALE WRESTLERS HAVE THE OPTION OF WRESTLING BOTH FOLKSTYLE AND FEMALE FOLKSTYLE STATE TOURNAMENT. IF WRESTLING IN BOTH TOURNAMENTS IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE EACH MATCH AS REQUIRED.

IMPORTANT WEIGH-IN INFORMATION:

ONE WEIGH-IN The athlete shall have two (2) attempts to make weight. The initial attempt when called to the scales and the immediate challenge of another scale. Athlete must show up at scale in singlet. **THE ALTHETE MAY NOT LEAVE THE WEIGH-IN AREA OR INTITATE ANY ACTIVE MEANS OF WEIGHT REDUCTION. NO COACHES OR PARENTS PERMITTED IN WEIGH-IN AREA.**
